

Olympic Disc Golf Rules 2025

Section 1 - General Provisions

Article 1.1 - Nature of the Game

Disc Golf is an outdoor activity similar to golf during which players throw specialized Frisbee-like discs and aim to get them into baskets in as few strokes as possible.

Article 1.2 - Authority

These rules govern all official Olympic Disc Golf matches and shall be interpreted and enforced by consensus among participating players. All participants are responsible for fair play and using competitive integrity to resolve disputes.

Section 2 - Rules

Section 2.1 - Baseline Rules

Section 3 - Event Format

Article 3.1 - Course

The event shall be played on a layout with eighteen (18) holes.

Article 3.2 - Medal Scoring

Medals shall be awarded according to the following hierarchy:

- a. The gold medal shall be awarded to the player with the fewest strokes
- b. The silver medal shall be awarded to the player with second fewest strokes
- c. The bronze medal shall be awarded to the player with third fewest strokes
- d. The finalist medal shall be awarded to the player with the fourth fewest strokes

Article 3.3 - Ties

If players finish with the same number of strokes, all tied players shall throw one shot on an agreed upon hole and ties shall be resolved awarding higher places to shots closer to the pin.
